Chad Friehauf Named 2004 Division II National Player of the Year

Colorado School of Mines quarterback Chad Friehauf won the 2004 Harlon Hill Trophy as the NCAA Division II College Football Player of the Year.

Friehauf finished the 2004 season with an NCAA Division II record 384 completions in 516 attempts (74.4%) for an NCAA Division II record 4,646 yards and 39 touchdowns, the 10th best for a single season in Division II history. He also ran 144 times for 717 yards and 15 touchdowns. Friehauf set an NCAA Division II record with 5,363 yards of total offense this season and his 412.5 total offensive yards per game was also an NCAA II single season record.

He finished his career as the all-time leader at CSM in passing attempts (1,183), pass completions (773), passing yards (9,873) and touchdowns (84).

The Harlon Hill Trophy is named in honor of Harlon Hill, a legendary wide receiver for the Chicago Bears, who played his collegiate football at the University of North Alabama. The award is voted upon each year by the Sports Information Directors in Division II.
